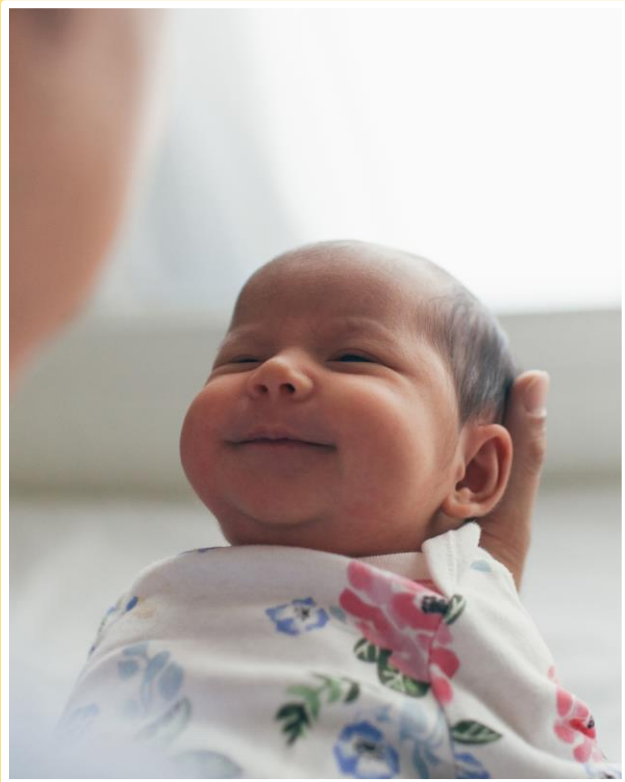

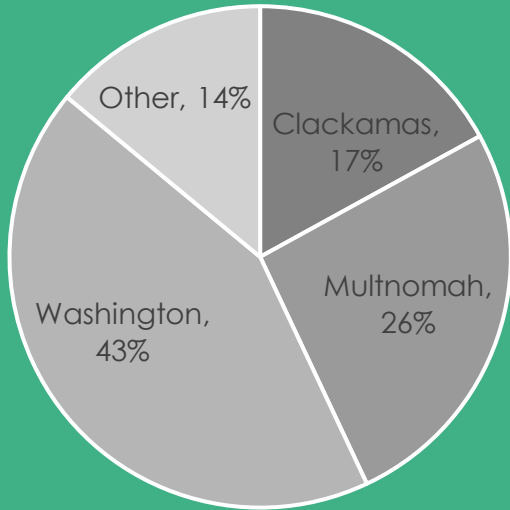

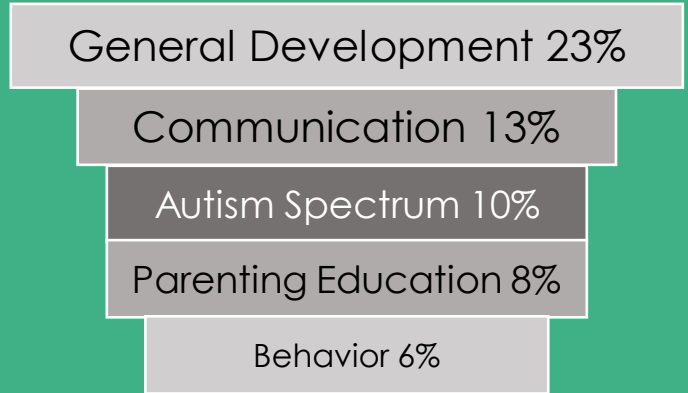

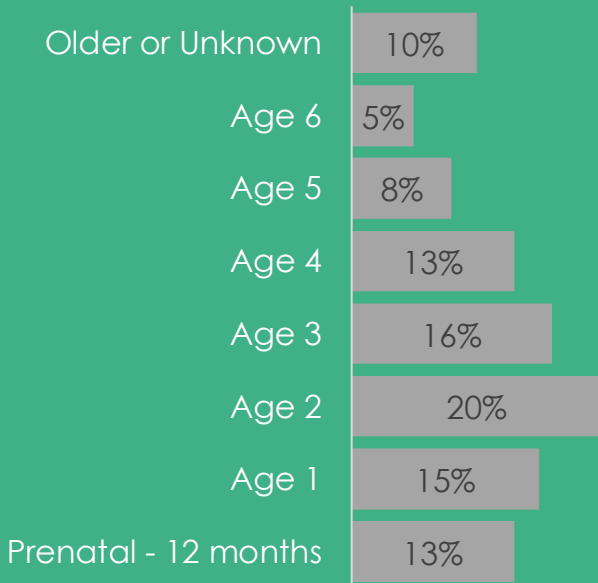

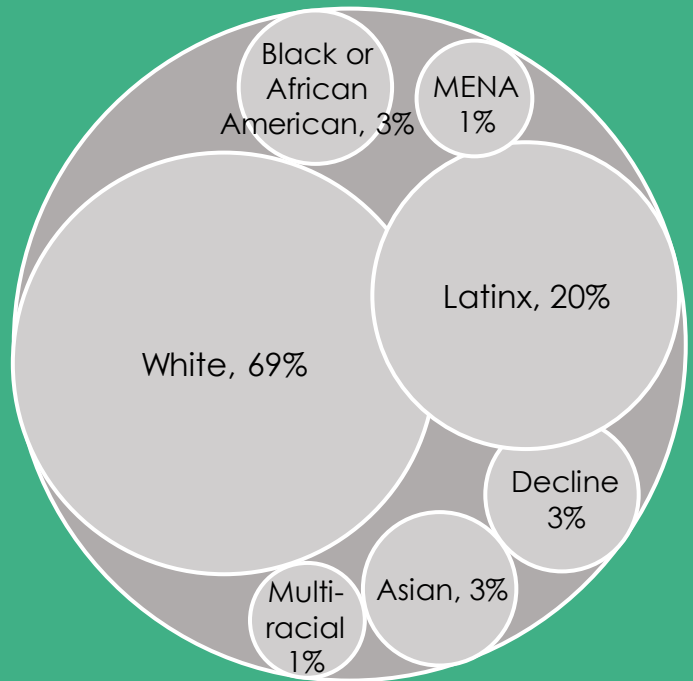
Top Reasons for Contacting HMG
